CONSENT AGREEMENT

FURTHERMORE, Respondent understands that this Consent Agreement is not effective until its acceptance by the Board. Respondent consents to the ex parte presentation of the Consent Agreement to the Board. Should this Consent Agreement not be approved by the Board, Respondent agrees that the presentation and consideration of this Consent Agreement by the Board shall not constitute a basis for disqualification of the Board or any of its members who participated in the preliminary panels or hearings from further participation in this matter, including a formal hearing.

FURTHERMORE, the Respondent has opted not to contest these specific findings before a formal Board hearing, (or Non-Judicial Conference) thereby consenting to accept the outlined disciplinary action as a basis for resolution of this complaint.



The Respondent further agrees that the Board shall retain jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this Consent Agreement. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this agreement shall be grounds for further disciplinary actions in the form of a civil penalty and/or suspension or revocation of Respondent's license.

FURTHERMORE, this agreement must be signed and returned to the Board office or rejected in writing by January 28, 2010.
