In 1963 two African Americans, Freddie Pitts, 54, and Wilbert Lee, 62, were wrongly

convicted by all-white juries in Port Joe, Florida for murdering two white gas station attendants.

They "confessed" after being severely beaten by police.

They spent 9 years on death row until a white man, Curtis Adams confessed to the crime.<sup>1</sup>

For years, African American leaders demanded just compensation for Pitts and Lee, in 1998 it was finally brought up for a vote in the legislature.

Jim Davis had a chance to do the right thing.
