- 2. I currently reside in Scottsboro, Alabama.

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3. In December of 1968, I treated John F. Kerry ("Kerry") in Cam Ranh Bay in connection with the slight injury for which he later claimed and received his first Purple Heart.

The crewmen with Kerry told me that there was no hostile fire, and that Kerry had inadvertently wounded himself with an M-79 grenade. This was



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baraly lodged in Kerry's arm. Further affiant saith not.
